

Video Internship – Summer

The Meijer State Games of Michigan is looking for a qualified intern to work with their Executive Director on the Summer Games. Applicants for this position must be able to work the Summer Games weekend events (June 18-19 and June 24-27).

Internship will start at the beginning of May and run through the end of June (start/end time can be adjusted based on school and internship requirements). The internship is 30-40 hours during the week with weekend work during events.

Where: The internship will take place in person at the offices of the West Michigan Sports Commission (300 Ottawa Ave NW Suite 240, Grand Rapids, Michigan). The intern will also be traveling to different venues for the Summer Games.

What: Intern will be working on the Meijer State Games of Michigan Summer Games and will be creating video content to promote the Summer Games.

Internship duties include but are not limited to creating short videos to promote events, filming and editing interviews, doing Facebook livestreams at major events (Opening Ceremony and sports events) and creating a recap of the events.
